Refund policy: If an exhibitor needs to cancel after payment, and the cancellation is made by January 9, SacTown VegFest will refund the payment in full. Cancellations made by January 19 will receive a 50 percent refund. No refunds will be made after January 19. No fee will be charged in the case of a declined application.





Conditions of Agreement

Please read and initial each item.

- 1. Each exhibitor must submit an individual application and payment.
- 2. SacTown VegFest will provide a minimum of one table and two chairs for each exhibitor/vendor.
- 3. Setup begins at 8:00 a.m. Exhibitors must be ready for operation by 9:45 a.m.
- 4. Exhibitors must staff their tables during the entire event—from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 5. Exhibitors must have clearly displayed signs that identify organization/business name, products, and prices where applicable.
- 6. Exhibitors shall display, sell, or give away only merchandise, literature, and services specified in the application.
- 7. All food or merhandise sold or given away must be vegan. Vegan means no animal products (e.g., flesh, animal fat, broth, gelatin, egg, dairy, or honey). All exhibitors/vendors should be able to answer questions about all ingredients/materials (no wool, no leather), and be sure no products involved animal testing.
- 8. Exhibitors and food court vendors must use compostable or recyclable packaging for food products. Our goal is a zero-waste event. Any questions, contact Scott at: OakParkSol@gmail.com.
- 9. SacTown Vegfest is a celebration of veganism and a place for information about veganism. With this double function in mind, SVS recognizes that graphic imagery can be a powerful education tool, but we want to maintain a celebratory atmosphere. Please keep the following guidelines in mind:
 - Any graphic imagery that attendees are forced to see is not allowed.
 - Graphic images inside of literature are acceptable and may be distributed (please specify in the product description and include a "graphic images" warning during SacTown VegFest).

If you have any questions, please contact us. We reserve the right to disallow any graphic imagery that does not fit within these guidelines on the day of the festival.

- 10. VegFest participants are requested to adhere to the SVS Mission Statement's "plant-based/vegan" message at VegFest—including no literature or messages promoting non-vegan foods, other products, or practices.
- 11. There is a wide spectrum of opinions and priorities in the plant-based/veg community. Please don't speak unkindly of points of view that differ from yours.
- 12. Should any contingency interrupt or prevent the holding of SacTown Vegfest, including but not limited to inclement weather, war, terrorism, or lockouts, the event coordinators and SacTown Vegfest shall in no way be liable to exhibitors. Should any contingency prohibit the event from taking place as scheduled, event coordinators will make their best effort to reschedule the event on a weekend day as near to the original date as possible.
- 13. Exhibitors agree to make no claim for any reason against event coordinators or SacTown Vegfest for theft, damage, or destruction of goods, or for injury to themselves, employees, volunteers, or visitors incurred at the event.
- 14. SacTown Vegfest may take photos and video of you and your exhibit table and use it for our promotions.
- 15. SacTown VegFest reserves the right to accept or reject any application at its discretion.
